Dear Parents/Carers

I hope that you and your family are well at this challenging time.

I wanted to contact you as we have been offered the opportunity of external support for our students who during this period may be struggling with specific issues.

Stuart Bailey from Norwich City's Community Sports Foundation (NCCSF) has produced a programme that covers a variety of different topics over a 5-week period. The themes covered are County lines & exploitation, drugs, cyberbullying, mental health awareness and coping mechanisms. The programme is fully supported, and part funded by Norfolk's Police Crime Commissioners office, and Social Services.

Stuart Bailey is the lead deliverer for the Foundations Positive Futures Protect programme and delivers a series of workshops aimed at young people from year 8 to year 13 covering all these subjects. As a police officer of 30 years, he has seen first-hand the outcomes of such issues but also the positive impact that intervention can provide.

Each session would be delivered using Microsoft Teams, and monitored by a member of staff acting as the host. After each session the participants will be able to access an online website designed by NCCSF that enables participants and families to watch 5 minute 'bitesize' reminders of each workshops content as well as safeguarding signposting advice if they or their families require further support.
