RAG Sixth Form Fundraising - May 2021

Each year sixth form students choose a charity to support in order to donate the proceeds of our annual RAG week fundraising. Over the last six years RAG week has raised £35,000 for six different charities.

The Sixth Form Leadership Team will be co-ordinating this year's RAG events in aid of our chosen charity, *Parkinson's UK*. Due to Covid-19 restrictions we have made some adjustments so that RAG events can still go ahead within year group bubbles. We will therefore host individual days as follows:

Year 7: Thursday 6 May & Friday 7 May
Years 8 & 9: Thursday 13 May & Friday 14 May
Years 10 & 11: Thursday 20 May & Friday 21 May

We will try to host as many events as possible within the Covid-19 safety guidelines that have been set out for us so that we can still enjoy this time and raise money for our charity. At all times social distancing and health and safety will be paramount. This year we will be offering:

- Guess the name of the bear (50p a go)
- Guess how many sweets are in the jar (50p a go)
- A sweet stall (all sweets pre-wrapped 72 hours before under strict hygiene guidance (£1)
- A raffle, with the chance of winning a signed NCFC shirt and ball (£3 a ticket or a strip of 5 for £12)
- A quiz teams enter with a chance of winning a prize for the best score (50p per person)

We ask that students bring in money to participate in these events. Please note we will not be able to offer change due to Covid-19 restrictions so exact amounts will be required.
