Re: Year 9 - Language Study

To: Parent/Carers – Year 8 Students

I am writing regarding your child/ward's study of languages in Year 9. Currently, all students study a combination of two languages, but from September 2024, your child/ward will study one language only.

We believe that focussing on one language in Year 9 for five lessons per fortnight will give your child/ward the best possible foundation required to succeed at GCSE. Therefore, we are giving our students the opportunity to express a preference of which language they would like to continue with in Year 9.

If your child/ward does not have a strong preference, we will allocate a language to them based on their progress so far in KS3. In this case, you do not need to respond.

However, if they would like to express a preference, this can be done using the link below by **3:00 pm on Friday 17 May 2024**. Any replies after this date will still be collated, but priority will be given to those preferences received before the deadline.
