- Check that your legal name and date of birth shown on the front of this timetable is correct as this will be printed on your certificate
- If any details regarding subjects are incorrect please speak to your subject teacher
- History: if you are taking GCSE History as an option please refer to the exam on 5 June 2025 am. On this morning you will sit two exam papers (1HI0 B3 & 1HI0 P4) which together total 1hr 50mins. The code 1HI0 2Q is showing the combined papers and overall duration.
- All the *Information for Candidates* notices from JCQ are on our website; please ensure you read these: <u>Students Examination Information</u>
- Clashes will be dealt with at a later date
- Arrive at least 10 minutes before the start of each exam
- Do not bring into the exam hall mobile phones, MP3/4 players or watches
- Please bring all necessary equipment for your exam; all pencil cases must be see through and only have the equipment required for the exam
- Water, not juice, may be brought into the exam hall but must be in a clear see through bottle with labels removed and no markings or logos on the side e.g. no sports bottles
- This is the only paper copy you will receive, so keep it safe you will be able to check your timetable details on your student portal
