Re: Year 11 Study Rooms after Half Term

After the half term break, some students may struggle to get to school later in the day for an afternoon exam and therefore will need to arrive at school first thing in the morning. For this reason, we are making study rooms available for quiet revision before afternoon exams. These will not be 'taught' revision sessions, but a space for students to prepare themselves. The rooms will be supervised by members of staff who have volunteered on a rota basis.

The room available is unlikely to contain revision materials or computers, so students will need to bring in their own work for this and will not be allowed to go wandering off round the school to look for things. In addition, any students who cause distraction or disturbance to others will be asked to leave the school site, and parents/carers will be notified.

Please note, if they have an exam in the morning *and* afternoon, and wish to stay in school, they will need to book in for a period 3 slot so that we know who is on site.
