WHAT'S HAPPENING IN...

The maths department warmly welcome a new member of the team – Mr Scoggins – and have very much enjoyed welcoming our new Year 7 students to Taverham High School. We have been very pleased with how the new students have settled in to our routines, arriving fully equipped with calculators and all the required equipment. The students were very positive about tackling their induction assessments, which will be used to double check that they are placed in an appropriate group to support them making the best possible progress and to enable their teachers to get to know them and to see where their strengths and knowledge gaps lie.

Year 7 have started out with some number work – looking at how place value affects calculations, working with negative numbers and using BIDMAS to ensure calculations are completed in the correct order.

Our year 8 and 9 students start in a similar area, continuing to build on this with our spiral curriculum that develops and extends knowledge and skills year on year.

Our year 10 students have made a good start to their Key Stage 4 studies and are demonstrating maturity tackling the start of their GCSE curriculum, while year 11 students have settled quickly to their work with mock exams to tackle only a few weeks from now.

It is exciting to see a cohort of A-level mathematicians begin their course in year 12 and we also welcome a group of students studying Core Maths again this year – a course that is studied alongside 3 A-levels and complements many of the A-Levels on offer here at Tayerham.

Year 13 students have tackled an assessment to start their year off ensuring that they are supported in the most bespoke way possible for their final year at Taverham Sixth Form.

A letter is coming out to year 7 and 8 parents/carers about a Parent Maths Workshop, inviting parents/carers to come into the maths classroom and brush up on their maths skills, so we look forward to meeting many of you there.

Congratulations go to Toby in year 8, who is a dedicated swimmer and, in August, qualified for the Summer Nationals Meet competition in Sheffield swimming the 200-metre backstroke.
