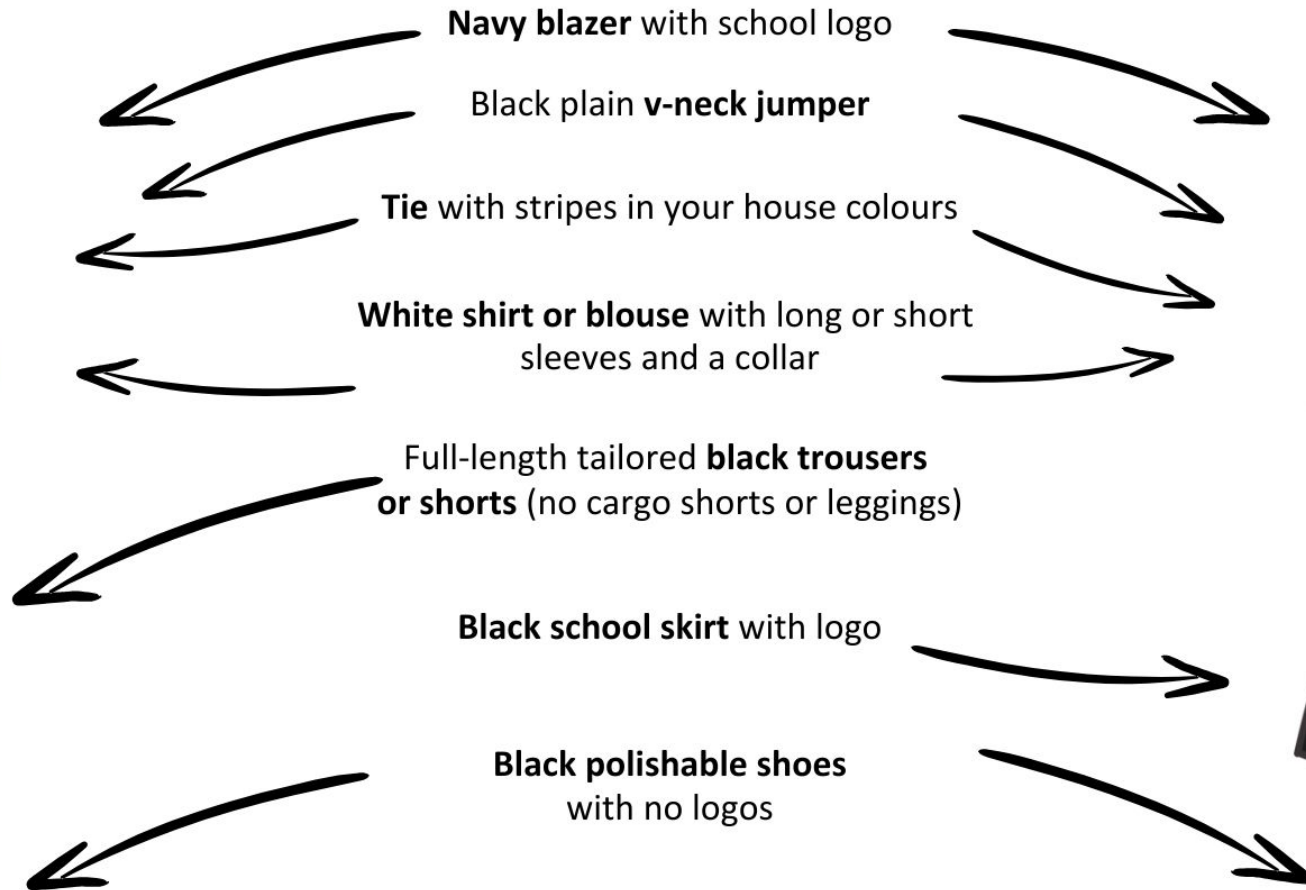

# Taverham High School Uniform



Your **outdoor coat** should be **black or navy**, warm and waterproof

# What will I need for my first day?

- A refillable **water bottle**.
- A **suitable bag** for your books and other equipment.
- **Snack / lunch** from home if you are not purchasing from the canteen.
- **Basic stationary** - black & green pens, pencil, ruler, eraser, calculator in a pencil case.



If you are using the canteen, you will need to set up your **cashless account on the WisePay App** where your parents / carers can **pay money in**. Once your account has credit in it, you **'pay'** for your food using your fingerprint. It is so easy!

## PE Kit

- **Sweatshirt** - Navy with school logo (optional).
- **Polo shirt** - Navy with royal blue panel and school logo.
- **Shorts/Skort** - Navy with royal blue panel, optional school logo.
- **Tracksuit bottoms** - Navy with school logo or plain navy.
- **Socks** - Royal blue.
- **Leggings** - Navy with school logo or plain navy thick material sports style type.
- **Trainers** - Ensure they offer suitable grip and support. Converse are not PE trainers.

# What happens in a school day?

You will follow a **two-week timetable**, which means your timetable will **alternate each week**.

On your first day you will **meet your form tutor** who will be able to answer your questions and explain how our rewards system works. You will have your **fingerprint taken** so that you can use the canteen and your **photo will be taken too**.

We will show you around the school during your **orienteeing session** and you will receive your **planner and timetable**, keep these safe.



We have a wonderful group of older students called **ELFs (Everybody's Listening Friend)** and our student **Here to Help (H2H)** team who will look after new students and help answer any questions. Our dedicated **Student Support Team** are on hand to provide emotional support and the **Head of Year** is there for students if they are upset, worried or have fallen out with friends, for example.

**In Years 10 & 11 you will study:** Maths, Science, English Language & Literature at GCSE alongside your GCSE options plus Personal Development, PE and Religious Studies. If you decide to stay on to Sixth Form (Years 12 & 13) you will choose from a range of subjects for your A-Levels.
