University entry 2025 launch

UCAS 2025



On 21 May we launched with Year 12 UCAS 2025 applications so students considering applying to university can start looking into their options and preparing their applications. As part of the launch we will take all Year 12s to the UCAS Norwich Discovery Day where students will have the opportunity to meet with UK university providers, find out about alternative pathways such as apprenticeships and the armed forces, all under one roof. At UCAS Discovery, they can chat to universities and colleges about their courses and university life, speak to employers and apprenticeship providers about what an apprenticeship is like and the options available as well as listen to talks from experts in their fields. This takes place on Monday 10 June.
