

INDEPENDENT STUDY – Preparation Consolidation Reflection

Remember you should be studying one hour independently for every hour of lesson time. In your independent study periods, once homework and assignments are complete, you should complete tasks from the following list:

Preparation- Religion topic

- 1 Read ahead using the OCR Religion text book
- 2 Work through tasks on each section using the workbook
- 3 Watch the Massolit lectures relating to our topics
- 4 Consider how the topic is related to Theatre and WHO. Be prepared to **raise these issues in class; mind map** the connections.
- 5 Refer to the **Secondary Sources** sheet and consider ways of incorporating these in class discussion

Consolidation- Religion topic

- 1 Re-read class notes regularly (every lesson).
- 2 Re-read sections from the text book (Religion).
- 3 Return to previously watched Massolit lectures
- 4 Complete practice questions in the text book.
- 5 Re-draft class notes and use the Secondary Sources sheet to develop 30 markers.

Reflection- All topics

- 1 Re-read essays and assessed pieces to 'learn' phrases and structures for the exam
 - 2 Revise Theatre visual sources: Use and dates
 - 3 Re-read the plays in sections, alongside your notes and Massolit lecture notes
- 4 Re-read the Epics in chunks (e.g. Telemachy, Supernatural books etc.)
- 5 Re-read Virgil text and re-watch relevant Massolit lectures
